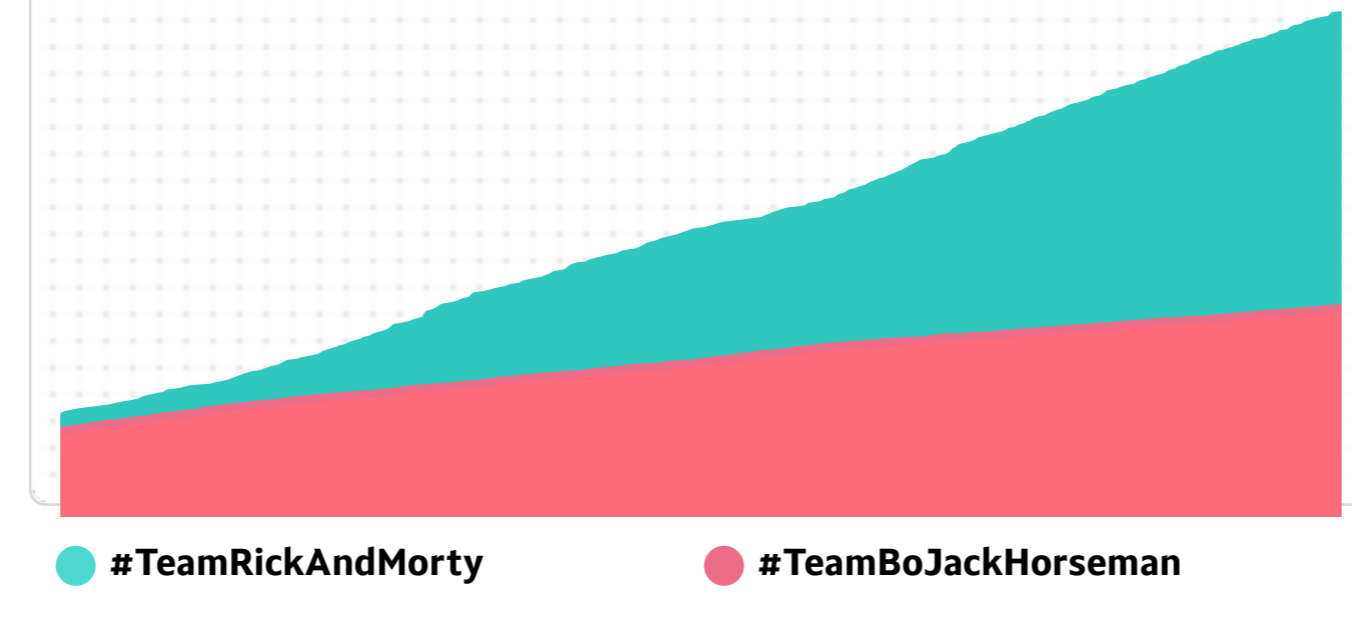
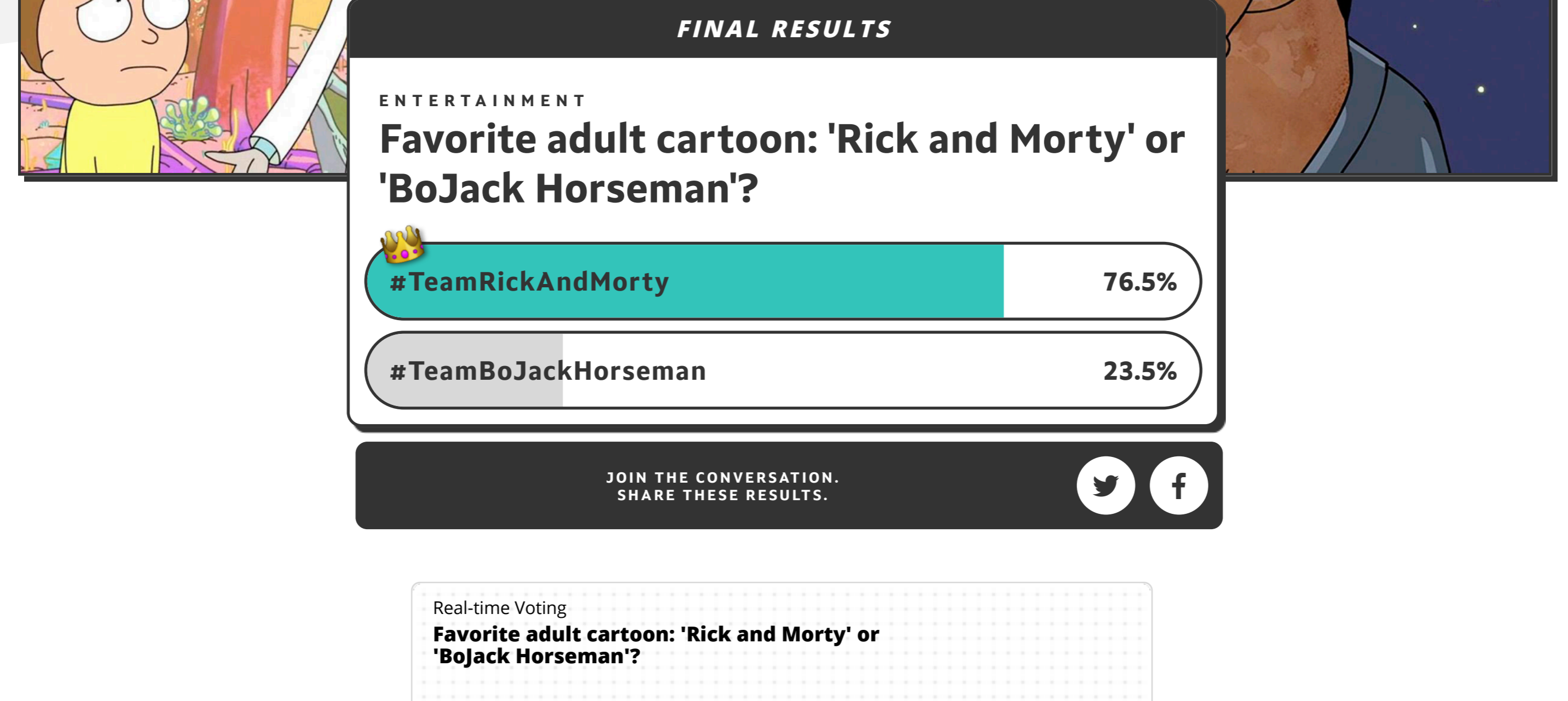

While the fanbases are obviously loyal, she writes these types of shows don't often get the respect they deserve because of preconceived notions that raunchy adult cartoons are only for twenty-something potheads.

But both shows clearly provide something their live-action counterparts do not. Intellectual cartoons are somewhat an escape from reality, adding the extra element of animation. However, these cartoons also depict real-life issues and topics within these fantasy-like animated worlds.

Dana writes about "BoJack Horseman":

After each new season of BoJack Horseman, every television critic and fan, for at least a week, becomes Robert Webb's Jesus, trying to convince people that it's actually possible for an animated show to be good. It's about a horse, but if you can believe it, it's actually intelligent. Just think of that for a minute: a smart animated show! Astonishing.

She also writes of "Rick and Morty":

Rick and Morty, on Adult Swim, is not notable for its emotional depth (or child-friendliness), but it's gained a massive and devoted fanbase for its exploration of scientific and philosophical questions with a zany flippancy.

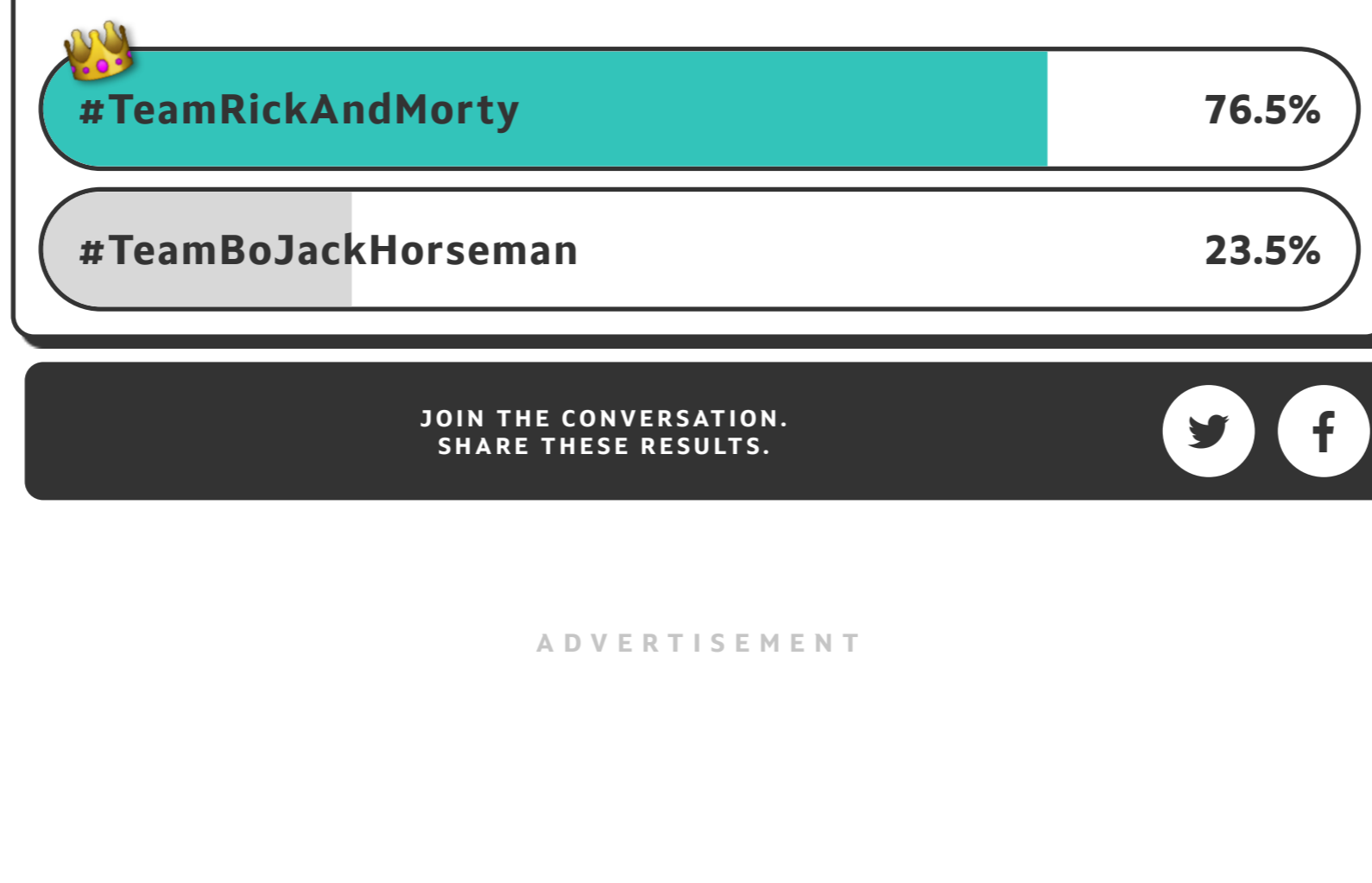
Below is the synopsis of "BoJack Horseman," per [IMDb](#).

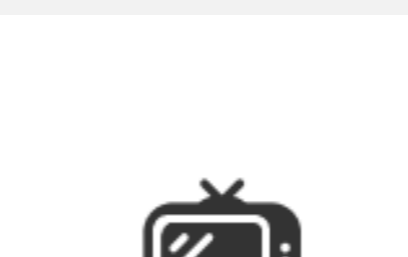
